 - iv. Direct the Board Clerk to mail notices to property owners in Davis and Woodland at least 14 days prior to the date of the public hearing.
- B. On motion by Commissioner Bunfill, seconded by Commissioner Herrgesell, and carried unanimously on a 4-0 roll call vote the Board voted to adopt Resolution 2023-2 authorizing the lien for parcel 027-430-003 in the amount of \$11,217.57 be placed on the tax roll.
